
Club Crew World Championships

What We Do

Our regular events include weekly dragon boat practices, outrigger canoeing, and various social and volunteer events throughout the year. Club members compete nationally and internationally with our dragon boat team - the Charleston Firebreathers - and independently by joining Team USA. Members also compete regionally in outrigger canoe events, both individually and as part of a crew.



Dragon boat racing is a dynamic water sport originating from ancient China. Teams paddle in long, narrow boats adorned with dragon heads and tails, competing to the beat of a rhythmic drum. Combining strength, teamwork, and tradition, it has become a popular and thrilling competitive sport, fostering camaraderie and fitness for all ages. The sport also embraces inclusion and celebration of cancer survivors and athletes with disabilities.

Modern dragon boat racing is organized at the international level by the International Dragon Boat Federation (IDBF). IDBF member associations or federations have been established in 89 countries or territories since 1991. Since then, its global appeal has led to highly competitive international racing events culminating every other year with the world's top dragon boat club crew teams converging for the ultimate showdown at the CCWC.
